

Kegan Clip 1 Transcript

BOB KEGAN: This is a class this week where we have an opportunity to more explicitly look at the relationship between the theory that we're exploring in the course and the main practice mode that we're exploring in the course.

So you've been, in various ways, invited into thinking about this theory of increasingly complex systems for constructing reality, looking out onto the world-- you know, a constructive developmental theory. And at the same time, you've been invited into your own version of the immunity to change practice.

And that is a practice which I told you is built on the theory. The two things are not accidentally related. But we haven't taken any real time to explicitly make that link. And that is kind of our main goal in this morning's class, in a way that should help you understand not just the relationship between the two of them better, but even to understand each of them better. And if we're successful, we will even have a chance to further a little bit your own work on your own kind of ITC journey, which is one of the reasons that we asked you to bring your own maps with you into class.
