

Cockrill Clip 6

[These facilitator notes provide commentary and ideas that might be helpful as you use these raw video clips with other educators.]

This clip illustrates the case-based approach in Cockrill's class. The small group that we observe here is a consistent team that remains together throughout the course. How do they support one another and learn together? Where do you see evidence of the trust they have built? We are struck by the high level of discourse, their willingness to be confused and corrected, and their smooth flow of conversation and collaborative problem solving.

We also note how this classroom experience mirrors the work of doctors. There is a realistic case. They are working as a team to make a diagnosis. They are asked to have a pithy report out, as they would if they were really in an emergency room.
