Mandell Clip 7

[These facilitator notes provide commentary and ideas that might be helpful as you use these raw video clips with other educators.]

We appreciate how Mandell ends class on a difficult but important question here, asking students in the room who identify as international students about the experience of negotiating with their American peers. It's a thought-provoking reflection question and builds on the earlier discussion about cross-cultural negotiations. Notice how Mandell reads the room after he poses the question and uses some humor to diffuse the tension before calling on a student volunteer. Why might he pose this question, knowing there's just a short time left? How does this clip make you think about the ways that you end class in your own courses?
